[TECHNICAL BLOCKING METHODS]		
<input type="checkbox"/>	#1 Adjust Robots.txt File - Instruct AI bots to ignore your website. (EXAMPLE) <i>User-agent: GPTBot</i> <i>Disallow: /</i>	YES Download Bot List as of Feb 2025
<input type="checkbox"/>	#2 Block AI with Meta Tags (HTML <head> code). (EXAMPLE) <code><meta name="robots" content="noai, noimageai"></code>	YES Download Example Code
<input type="checkbox"/>	#3 Block AI with HTTP Headers (Server-Side) (EXAMPLE - Apache) <code><IfModule mod_headers.c></code> <code>Header set X-Robots-Tag "noai, noimageai"</code> <code></IfModule></code>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	#4 IP Blocking – Identify and block known AI bot IP ranges at the server level.	YES Download known Ips

<input type="checkbox"/>	#8 Issue DMCA Takedown Notices (if necessary).	
<input type="checkbox"/>	#9 Send Cease and Desist Notices.	
[CONTENT MODIFICATION STRATEGIES]		
<input type="checkbox"/>	#10 Serve key content through JavaScript to make direct scraping harder (called "JavaScript Obfuscation"). <i>(Nuclear option and excessive in our humble opinion)</i>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	#11 Use authenticated API calls to dynamically load content. <i>(Another nuclear option and excessive in our humble opinion)</i>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	#12 Embed invisible watermarks (identifiers) in your content.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	#13 Gate your content from AI (gating content is a common marketing tactic - think WSJ.com or New York Times online articles).	
[SEO & SEARCH ENGINE DIRECTIVES]		
<input type="checkbox"/>	#14 One-off search engine & simple SEO directives to block AI. <i>A) At the micro level, use the meta tag block from above on a case-by-case basis.</i> <i>B) Block AI Proxies (other servers or services relaying bot requests anonymously).</i>
